1. PURPOSE OF THE POLICY

The MWNA apparel forms part of the MWNA branding strategy and is an important element in our public image. This policy establishes guidelines for the provision and wearing of the apparel.

2. EXECUTIVE COMMITTEE MEMBERS

Executive members are to be provided with:

- Jacket to be provided initially and when required
- Dress shirt (for more formal events) to be provided at a minimum of every 2 years
- Polo shirt to be provided at a minimum of every 2 years
- Casual pants (long and ¾ length) with a skirt option to be provided initially and when required
- Shoulder type carry bag with MWNA logo

Wearing of Apparel

Executive members are to wear the MWNA approved Executive attire only whilst undertaking Executive duties either at the Netball courts during competition days or other official functions.

3. OTHER MWNA PERSONNEL

Can be provided with a MWNA approved polo shirt and jacket which is only to be worn whilst undertaking MWNA duties. Club attire to be worn whilst performing Club duties.

4. COACHES/MANAGERS

- Team Personnel participating at Netball NSW events to be provided with 2 MWNA approved polo shirts every 2 years.
- Development/Summer Series/Talent team personnel are to be provided with 1 MWNA approved polo shirt every 2 years.
- Should any team personnel be elected to another team that attend State Titles in an official capacity will receive a 2nd shirt.
- Tracksuit jacket
- Tracksuit pants
- Backpack / sports bag

Wearing of Apparel

MWNA Team personnel must wear MWNA approved apparel only whilst undertaking official MWNA duties. i.e attendance at team training session, matches and carnivals.

5. REPRESENTATIVE PLAYERS

Representative Team Members

- Kit Bag and drink bottle to be provided upon initial selection in a State Titles team.
- A new drink bottle is provided every year
- Purchase approved State titles team uniform at prices set by MWNA:
 - Playing uniform
 - Training Singlet
 - Tracksuit jacket and pants
 - Socks

Development Team Members

- Backpack and drink bottle to be provided upon initial selection in a MWNA Development team
- A new drink bottle is provided every year
- Purchase approved Development team uniform at prices set by MWNA
 - o Playing uniform
 - Training singlet
 - o Hoodie
 - o Track pants
 - Socks

Talent Squad Members

- Backpack and drink bottle to be provided upon initial selection in a MWNA Talent team
- Purchase approved Talent team uniform at prices set by MWNA
 - Playing uniform
 - Training singlet
 - Hoodie
 - o Track pants
 - Socks

Wearing of Apparel

MWNA representative, development and talent squad team members must wear the MWNA approved apparel whilst undertaking MWNA representative duties only. When members have completed their MWNA duties they should change to casual clothing or to their local Club apparel.

6. REPRESENTATIVE UMPIRES

- MWNA appointed umpires participating in Netball NSW endorsed events will receive MWNA Umpires Uniform
- Umpires appointed to State Titles (Senior & Junior) will receive 1 shirt just prior to the State Title weekend
- New shirts will be provided at a minimum of every 2 years
- Appointed MWNA Representative team umpires will receive MWNA tracksuit jacket and blue pants
- Socks can be purchased at own cost
- MWNA backpack or sports bag can be purchased.

Wearing of Apparel

- 1. Approved Manly Umpires shirt umpire's shirt to be worn at State Titles (Senior and Junior)
- 2. Approved Manly Umpires shirt to be worn at all carnivals when representing MWNA as an umpire.
- 3. Club Umpires shirt to be worn whilst umpiring Club games during any MWNA Competition.
- 4. Umpire Committee members to wear MWNA approved Umpires Committee shirt and Jacket whilst representing the MWNA Umpires Committee during MWNA Competitions.
